



Hello Michael

I am sending you pictures of my horse Renegade's feet after being in the Easy Walker Shoes for 30 days as of today. We have a shoeing scheduled in about 12 days and I will send more photos then. I wanted you to see them at about mid way and at the end of a shoeing cycle. As I explained on the phone we are involved in 50 mile endurance racing. We have trained each week since the shoeing at least 30 to 40 miles over various terrain, to include rocks, gravel of various size, mud, wet grass, pavement and broken pavement, sand and dirt forest service roads. This is in the mountains of Western North Carolina, USA.

I have always been interested in the idea of this kind of shoe but have been disappointed in the past having tried a different brand. That particular shoe and therefore the foot just did not hold up even after easy use. However the Easy Walker Shoe has been fantastic. They are light weight yet very strong so Renegade moves out very well with no tripping or forging. The shoe grips very well on all the surfaces I mentioned so far with the exception of wet grass. We slide in wet grass no matter what kind of shoe we have on. The shoes are great on pavement, no sliding at all. Some of the forest service roads have unexpected areas of old pavement under the dirt that in the past have caused sliding bad enough to either scare you to death or actually cause an accident. The Easy Walker shoes have solved that problem.

Of course the main reason I am writing this to you is that I love the shoe, my horse loves the shoe and his feet have held up very well in this shoe. I thank you very much for the development of this product as the impact of many, many miles of serious riding on my horse's feet and legs and joints will be greatly lessened over the years!
